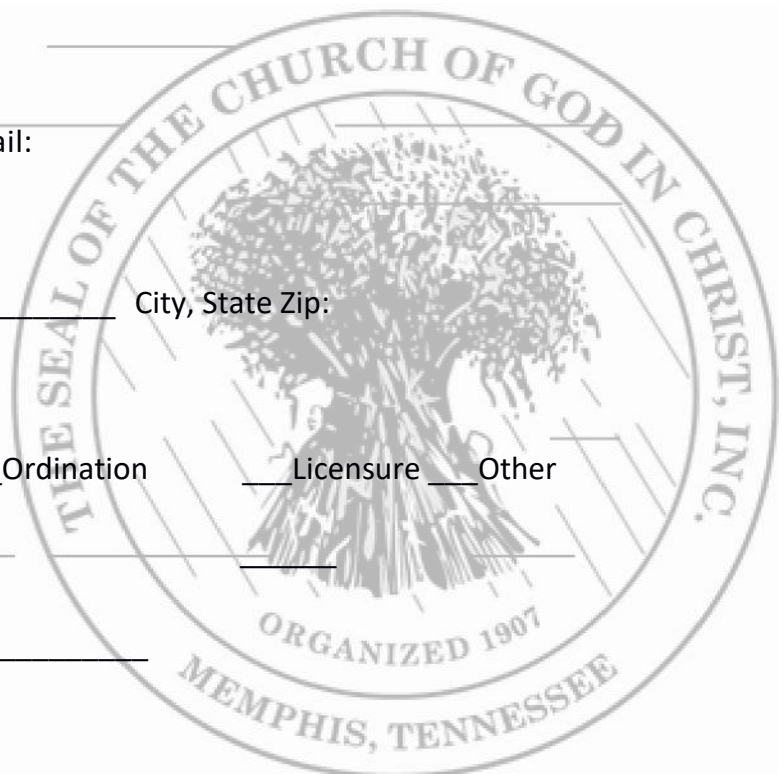

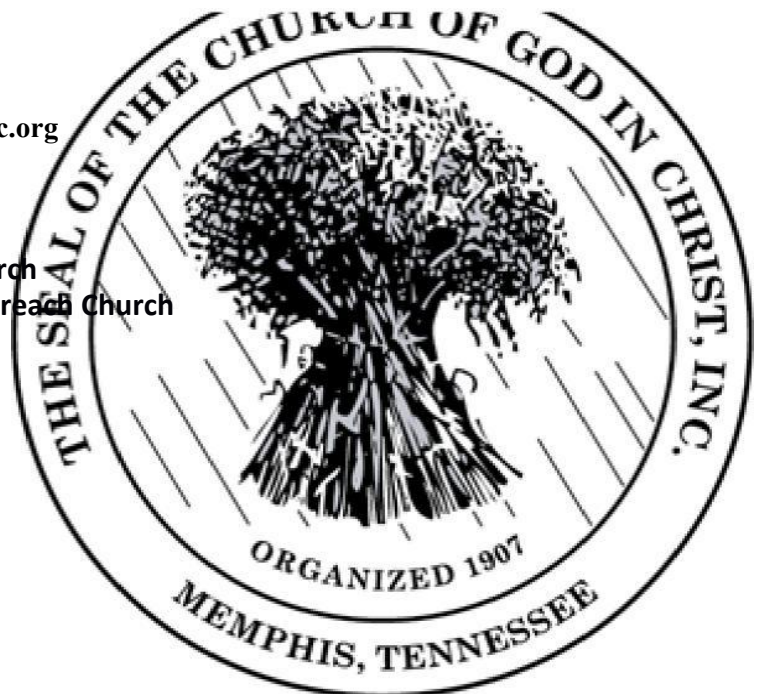

Course Overview

I. Old Testament I & Old Testament II

A basic overview of the Old Testament inclusive of not only study of the literature, but also themes and principal from the life, history and thought of ancient Israel that are applicable to contemporary Christian life and ministry. A special emphasis will be placed on the development of Pentecostal and Holiness hermeneutics in biblical interpretation.

II. New Testaments

A study of the literature of the New Testament in its historical, cultural, social, political, and canonical contexts. It also emphasizes the faith and ethics of early Christianity. A special emphasis will be placed on the developmental of Pentecostal and Holiness hermeneutics in biblical interpretation.

III. COGIC Doctrine and Polity

A study of the history, constitution, government and organization of the Church of God in Christ, Inc covering key events, transitional moments, major periods, and outstanding leaders.

IV. COGIC Social Ethics

A study of Christian faith as it is affirmed and lived out in the Church of God In Christ, Inc. The course examines theology, **doctrine** and moral values distinct to the Church of God In Christ.

V. Church Administration

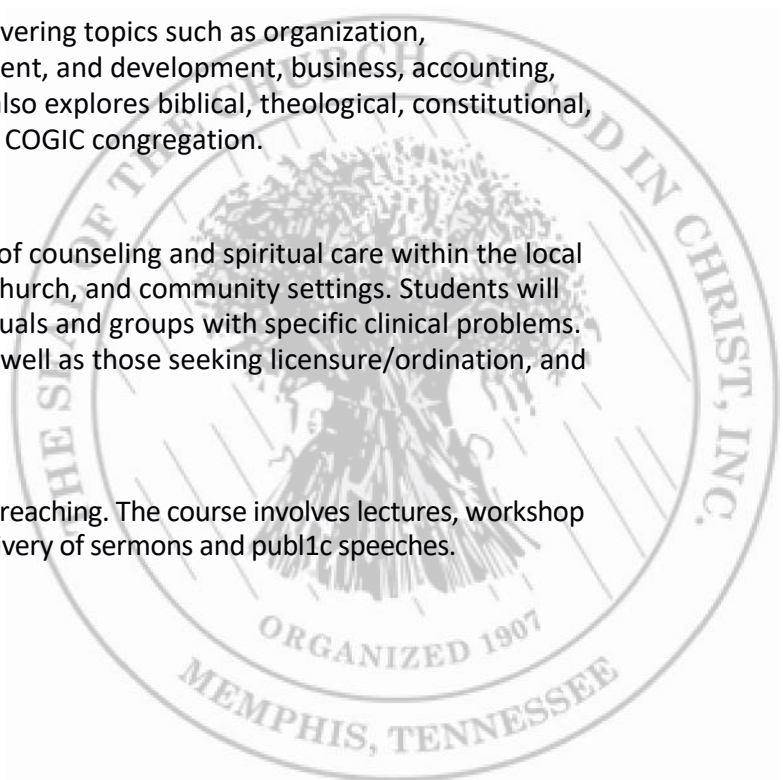
A course on administration in the local church covering topics such as organization, management, office development, staff recruitment, and development, business, accounting, finance, payroll, taxes, and so forth. The course also explores biblical, theological, constitutional, and moral bases for effective administration of a COGIC congregation.

VI. Pastoral Counseling

A study of theological foundations and methods of counseling and spiritual care within the local church, medical center, retirement home, Para-church, and community settings. Students will learn the appropriate skills for counseling individuals and groups with specific clinical problems. This course will serve the needs of laypersons as well as those seeking licensure/ordination, and recertification.

VII. Homiletics

This course offers a study in methods of effective preaching. The course involves lectures, workshop sessions, preparation of sermons, and the oral delivery of sermons and public speeches.

Course Overview

VIII. Spiritual Leadership

The goal of this course is to offer an examination of religious leadership for church and society. The course looks critically and theologically at readings and case studies, encouraging learning and reflection on various styles and models of leadership for effective ministry.

IX. Evangelism and Missions

Making explicit the biblical command to preach the gospel to all humankind and make disciples of all persons, the course examines various methods of spreading the gospel and winning persons to Jesus Christ, for the purposes of winning new converts as well as achieving growth of existing churches.

X. Women in Ministry

The course examines the works and contributions of women in the holiness and Pentecostal movements. The course covers the biblical and theological bases for the roles of women and the unique structuring of women's work in the Church of God In Christ. The Church of God In Christ Women's Department is examined at the international, jurisdictional, district, and local level.
